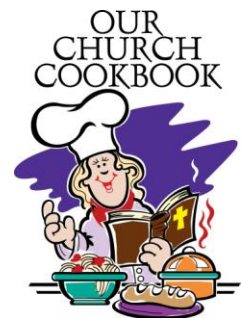
Coming Up

FINANCE



The finance committee reviews and discusses both amounts taken in and amounts spent by Gloria Dei. The following are issues which always affect the financial health of the congregation:

- Amounts given by members and visitors are larger in early and late months of the year, with the most donated in December. Therefore, summer months are challenging ones from a bill paying perspective.
- Special giving by members and others allows for non-budgeted projects and items to be purchased, but does NOT increase the amount available to pay for operating expenses.
- Thus, overall giving may be increased, **but money to pay operating bills may be insufficient.** Money earmarked to specific items such as education, memorials, etc. cannot be used for shortfalls in the operating budget.
- Some amounts budgeted for expenses, such as insurance are estimates and others, such as salaries are known. When actual bills exceed estimates, managing within the budget is challenging.
- Money from Mission/Enduring Fund has been authorized by the Church Council to be used to pay some operating expenses for five years, **ending after 2010.** Gloria Dei Education Fund can be used to support Vacation Bible School, Sunday School, the Youth Leader position, scholarships and any other educational activities.

2009 is a year where there have been positive and negative financial news.

- Giving has increased when compared to this time in 2009.
- The increase has been larger in "special giving", than in operating funds.
- The damaged sign will be replaced by the insurance company.
- Expenses are increased over budgeted amounts due largely to repair expenses (air conditioning, dishwasher) and much higher than estimated insurance costs.

We are currently, therefore **over budget** in spending. This has necessitated a larger than budgeted contribution from Mission/Enduring Fund to the operating budget. We are hopeful that our December giving will not only pay operating expense, but also allow for some return to M/E Fund. **We look forward to your additional support in this need.**

We continue to discuss ways to cut operating expense without putting the growth and mission of Gloria Dei in jeopardy.

We are optimistic about our growth in membership, about the increases in giving and will try to reduce some expenses. We look forward to the challenge of budgeting and managing in 2010.

STEWARDSHIP

But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully 2 Corinthians 9:6

Members of Gloria Dei Lutheran Church should be excited by our accomplishments in 2009. We have reached out spiritually and monetarily to our community as well as providing our members with an environment in which to enjoy worship. Shall we as a Church of God continue to joyfully spread God's word and do God's work or, because of worries about budgets and funding, pull back into a safe shell and "sow sparingly"?

We have just completed our Fall Stewardship campaign and many of you have pledged to contribute to support the Gloria Dei ministry. Of 102 envelopes mailed out, 36 were returned. Many Lutherans do not respond to pledge requests. You generously support a need when that need is identified. Only 35% of the Faith Promise cards were returned. Yes, it is hard to commit in light of our Nation's current economy.

Most members understand congregational giving is extremely important but take a rather passive interest. The Stewardship Committee is "handling that". But when so many members do not return their pledge cards, we are not providing the information so necessary to allow Staff and Council *to plan a realistic budget* for the coming year. In 2008 our expenditures were near \$225,000. At year's end we had received approximately \$140,000 in gifts. Remaining expenditures were covered by withdrawing from the Mission Enduring Fund. The Faith Promise cards returned on Christ is King Sunday contained pledges for \$68,435. Our budget for the growth and missions we all believe necessary and our obligation to Christ will be near \$210,000. Because our pledges support only 1/3rd of our plan to do God's work, we must ask each member to consider increasing their 2010 giving. If you have already pledged an increase, God bless you. If you have not pledged, please remember all the special projects we have accomplished this past year. The Temple Talks presented the last 3 weeks of November highlighted the many wonderful things accomplished during 2009. Please, help to support our church family and the community again in 2010. The goal is to achieve full funding for our "growth" budget. Consider this simple math. If each household in the congregation increased their gifts by \$5 a week, assuming we serve 110 member households, the \$5 is \$550/week times 52 weeks for an increase of \$28,600. A \$10 increase per week would be \$57,200, an amount which would approach *full funding* of our ministry. If we do not realize an increase in gifts, we will either need to "sow sparingly" or withdraw from the Mission Enduring Fund to support our expenditures. That fund can not continue to sustain yearly withdrawals.

With our member's committed support, we can reach our goals together, securing the future of our Christian family and Gloria Dei Lutheran Church.

Advent is about the "coming days." God's people have always lived in great expectation, but that expectation finds specific, repeated enunciation in the texts appointed for these four weeks.

Advent 1 Nov. 28-29

Luke 21:25-36 God will fulfill God's purposes and, already, hidden signs of that fulfillment abound.

Advent 2 Dec. 5-6

Luke 3:1-6 John the Baptist heralds the way of the Lord, whose way is prepared by "repentance for the forgiveness of sins."

Advent 3 Dec. 12-13

Luke 3:7-18 John the Baptist heralds the mighty one "who is coming."

Advent 4 Dec. 19 & 20

Luke 1: 39-55 In Elizabeth's inspired greeting and Mary's song of praise we hear of a saving God who remembers, scatters, lifts up, and fulfills all things.

The Nativity of Our Lord

In the familiar account of Christ's birth, the evening sky is bright with the heavenly host singing, "Glory to God in the highest." Amid our broken world we

proclaim that the prince of peace is born among us. God comes to us in human flesh—in Christ's body and blood—so that we may be bearers of divine light to all the world.

Christmas Eve

God's greatest gift comes as a baby in a manger. Angels announce the "good news of great joy" and proclaim God's blessing of peace. Carols, Candlelight and Holy Communion will shape our Festival Worship as we gather once again to behold the new born King. Special Music begins at 6:30pm and 10pm just prior to 7pm and 10:30pm.

Christmas Day

On this Christmas morning the people of God gather to celebrate the birth of the Word made flesh, Christ our Lord. The meaning of Christmas is made clear: the light shines in the darkness. Worship at 9:30am.

Lessons and Carols

December 26th and 27th we gather to sing familiar carols and hear once again the scriptures foretelling Jesus' birth.
