Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“Karibuni sana kwa Tanzania!”

“You all are warmly welcomed to Tanzania!”

Even before we boarded the plane in Dulles, VA to Tanzania, Ken Fuchs and I have been greeted with the Swahili greeting, **“Karibuni sana kwa Tanzania!”** We have been planning for months--ever since we hosted the Bukoba Choir and were invited to travel to Tanzania as they celebrate the 100th jubilee of the ELCT—North Western Diocese. Preparations included inoculations at the Manatee Health Department (yellow fever, hepatitis and typhoid vaccines), securing passports and visas and of course, anti-malaria pills. There are over 5 million Lutherans in Tanzania (the merger of Tanganyika and the island of Zanzibar)—that's more than the number of Lutherans in the Evangelical Lutheran Church America. Pastor Dwayne Westermann is President of the Godparents for Tanzania (a public charity that provides scholarships to over 120 students in the Kilimanjaro and Karatu regions of Tanzania.) I met Pastor Westermann when he was pastor at College Lutheran at Salem, VA. He is now retired and spends his time working to provide scholarships for students to attend secondary school/college in Tanzania.

We will worship with our brothers and sisters in Tanzania and visit local areas—one highlight is our game safari. As we travel we pray that you will hold us and the people of Tanzania in your prayers as we continue to pray for you as well. On the next page you can view our itinerary.

1. All obligations to the Florida Bahamas Synod and Gloria Dei Mission Support have been fulfilled year to date.
2. We continue to track very well with respect to the 2010 spending plan (95.4% of budget).
3. Congregational contributions are up slightly (110% year over year).
4. YTD we have still had to utilize Mission Enduring Funds to help facilitate our expenses.
