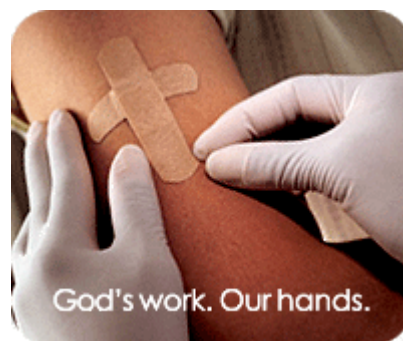

Gloria Dei will host the families on Friday evening January 29th at Roser Church beginning with the meal 5-8pm and then providing overnight hosts.

Choir Risers

When we explored the possibility of constructing the Risers for the Gloria Dei Church Choir, we realized quickly that the framing material, the flooring and the hand rails could be very expensive. The wood flooring everyone chose would be \$1200. The price of the hand railing was also shocking. Newell posts would be \$100 each and we needed 8. The flooring became affordable when all agreed to use laminate at 1/3 the cost of real hardwood.

We approached John, the owner of Manatee Lumber. John listened to our story about not being able to afford \$100 Newell posts and our need for Risers at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church. Then John suggested maple, not oak. John has suffered a severe stroke so you must give him time to express his ideas. John offered us 8' maple pieces at \$20 each (vs. \$100). Yes, John said they would have to be finished and fluting added so John, who can do that? Our obvious question. Clyde Redmond was his answer. In the end, John ended up "selling" us lots of maple not only for the Newell posts but for the top railing also.

Clyde Redmond has a small shop off 301 Expressway and 63 Ave. We worked with Clyde to fabricate the railing that somewhat matched the Alter railing. We showed Clyde photos of the fluting, the Alter, the location where we intended to build the Risers. He was a very easy guy to work with.

Sometime, maybe our third visit, Clyde dropped the bomb. He was an Acolyte at GDLC as a boy. His family had lived on the Island and was members of GDLC from 1967 to 1975. Clyde remembered many details about the church to include worshipping in ankle deep water before the windows in the roof were replaced. And Clyde Jr. and Clyde Sr. have a different story about the leaking skylights in the roof. Apparently the original contractor decided to cut out, remove a beam that was in the walk way between the narthex and the Alter. The contractor deduced that the beam was not supporting anything so he cut it out. The Beam however was not for support a load but holding down the roof and prevents flexing of the roof under wind load. Flexing compromised the window joints, the reason for leaking skylights. The reason for the leaking windows remains in contention but Walter Kramer confirms that a cut off beam remains in the A/C crawl way.

Clyde Redmond Jr. tolerated our not knowing what we really wanted. Of course, we knew what it should look like but was it to be 2.75" or 3.25". So the guy who served an Acolyte from 1967 to 1975 is the one responsible for the precise angle of the top rail, the fluting in the front Newell posts. Judith and I had fun working with Clyde Jr. We also hope we have made a new friend.

Christmas—Epiphany Worship at Gloria Dei

January 3rd—2nd Sun. of Christmas

John begins his gospel with this prologue: a hymn to the Word through whom all things were created. This Word became flesh and brought grace and truth to the world.

Epiphany Eve—January 5th

Epiphany means "manifestation." We celebrate the revelation of Christ to the Gentiles—that is, to all nations. Some Christian traditions celebrate three great epiphanies on this day: the magi's adoration of the Christ child, Jesus' baptism in the Jordan River, and his first miracle, in which he changes water into wine. The word and sacraments are for us the great epiphany of God's grace and mercy. We go forth to witness to the light that shines brightly in our midst.

January 10th

Baptism of Our Lord

The reading opens with questions about the identity of the Messiah. John the Baptist insists that he is not the Messiah; instead he points ahead to one who is coming. And whether the voice of God was heard by all or only by Jesus, God settles the matter: Jesus is God's beloved Son.

January 17th 2 Epiphany

Turning water to wine at the wedding at Cana is described as the first of Jesus' signs. Through many such epiphanies, Jesus reveals that he bears God's creative power and joyful presence into the world.

January 24th 3 Epiphany

Near the beginning of Jesus' public ministry, he visits his hometown of Nazareth. In the words of Isaiah, he states and claims his identity, purpose, and mission.

January 31st 4 Epiphany

People in Jesus' hometown are initially pleased when he says that God will free the oppressed. Their pleasure turns to rage when he reminds them that God's prophetic mission typically pushes beyond human boundaries so that mercy and healing are extended to those regarded as outsiders.

February 7th 5 Epiphany

Jesus' teaching of God's word has begun to draw great crowds. For Simon, James, and John, Jesus' teaching inspires hospitality, then obedience, and then risk. After Jesus' creative power is revealed, fear and amazement lead these three fishermen to leave everything behind in order to become apostles.

February 14th Transfiguration

The conversation about Jesus' suffering and death is enclosed in a dazzling foreshadowing of the resurrection. God affirms Jesus' identity, the disciples are stunned speechless, and Jesus resumes his mission with a demonstration of his power over evil.

February 17th Ash Wednesday

Lent begins with a solemn call to fasting and repentance as we begin our journey to the baptismal waters of Easter. As we hear in today's readings, now is the acceptable time to return to the Lord.
